

DIVA HAIR PONYTAIL INSTRUCTIONS

Ponytails are always in style. Whether you are going to the gym or hitting the town a ponytail is a simple, elegant option. With Diva Hair's Invisible Clip Ponytail you can instantly create a long, full ponytail that blends seamlessly and looks just like your own hair. This trendy do-it-yourself pony style is 18 inches long and is easy to apply. Just clip, wrap around and go! Transform your plain ponytail into a pony style that makes a statement. Experiment with different placement to create different ponytail looks.

Part of Diva's accessory collection, you can style this clever pony any way you want - just as you would your own hair. The heat friendly synthetic fiber makes it easy to flat iron, curl or blow dry. Plus, it looks and feels like real hair.

Go straight to wavy or add extra curl, using the diva flat iron. The artificial fiber can withstand heat from 240 to 350 degrees Fahrenheit. You can easily achieve any straight look using a (temperature controlled) flat iron. If you use a curling iron, be sure to hold the curl for approx. 60 seconds then clip and allow to cool, to set the curl in. The style stays locked in place until heat-styled again. We recommend heat styling off of the head for safety.

TIP

Caring for your new hair product is easy, and you should treat your new product as an investment that you want to keep looking new and fresh for a

as long as possible. The correct care and maintenance will allow you to continue using the product with the best results for the longest amount of time. So, use the following instructions as a gauge for determining how and when you should wash and care for your products.

USING THE PONYTAIL

Step 1: Gather Your Hair. Brush your hair into a ponytail and secure with an elastic band.



Step 2: Secure In Place. Slip straight comb under the rubber band. Tip: The teeth should be pointing back (not straight down).



Step 3: Wrap Wrap base around ponytail. Wrap side section of hair around your ponytail, concealing the elastic and secure with a bobby pin (or two).



And you're done!



CLEANING THE PONYTAIL

Just like your own hair, synthetic hair will accumulate residue through normal wear. However, you do not need to wash the synthetic hair everyday to keep consistent results. The fiber should be washed as infrequently as possible or when you notice that the fiber appears dull. If you are wearing the hair all day, every day, you can wash them after 4-6 wearings.

- Before shampooing, gently remove any tangles or teasing with your fingers or a pick comb. Do not brush.
- Add one teaspoonful of any mild shampoo to two quarts cold - never hot - water.
- Immerse the hair and soak 3-5 minutes, then gently swish up and down. Do not rub.
- Rinse thoroughly twice in cold water.
- Dab gently with a towel to remove excess water.
- Do not squeeze or twist.
- While still wet, spray with a leave in conditioner that is specifically formulated for synthetic hair goods.
- Dry on a towel at room temperature.
- Style with fingers or pick comb. Do not use hair dryer, blow dryer or curling iron. Avoid excess heat. Do not brush or comb while wet.

CARE BETWEEN WEAR

Spray with a light mist of leave-in conditioner (specifically formulated for synthetic fiber) to keep your hair looking fresh and healthy.

Gently remove any tangles using your fingers or pick comb.

A water soluble hair spray may be used for a light hold.

Remember:

Blow dryers, curling irons and other thermal tools are not recommended, but if you do use them, please follow the instructions.

Because the curl pattern (or lack of a curl pattern) is baked into the fiber, it is not necessary to set your synthetic hair after washing. However, if you wish, wet setting is the safest way to curl your hair.

You may want to have the hair custom cut to achieve your desired style. **DO NOT ATTEMPT TO CUT IT YOURSELF.** Take your product to a salon professional.

Synthetic hair cannot be coloured!

Storing the Hair: It is best to store the synthetic hair in its original container. However, you can store the hair in a plastic bag.

To keep the desired curl pattern, you may want to set the hair on rollers that conform to the curl size you wish to maintain before storing in plastic.

Do not sleep or swim while wearing the synthetic hair.
